



How do we create amazing artist research?

Shepard Fairey

(Assessment Objective 1: Investigate)

Print 5 images of each artist (include the artist name and title of work)

Annotate (and use 'Jump In' sheet

Describe: Describe the image. (Colours, size, mood)

Materials: What materials and processes have been used? (Pencil, paint, collage, printing, sewing)

Message: The message behind this piece of artwork is...

Ideas: This artist has inspired me to...

(Assessment Objective 2/3 Experiment and Record)

Copy their work (sketches, accurate drawings, stencils, stamps, paint, large scale drawings, digital artwork/[befunky/obamaposter](#))

(Assessment Objective 4: Personal Response)

Recreate one of the images: Obama Poster/Your own photos/your own stencils (to understand how the artist creates their own work)

Next steps: Further experimentation...
explore your ideas to develop a final piece

How to analyse images in Art and Photography

Apply this technique to create a personal response to artist's work

Follow the steps to create your artist research:

- 5 Images
- Analyse
- Copy/photocopy
- Recreate in your own style

Start with... key words

What has happened before/after?

What would you ask them?

Next steps...

- How has it been made?
- What is the mood like?
- How can you personalise this if you want to match it?

Imagine you are there....

- Tell me what they are looking at?
- How are they feeling?
- Do you feel comfortable?
