Threading up a Machine



(1.5) long sleeves also gather around the umpit & elbow waist & bottom, usually 3) pants of trousers gather aroungerin, knees, of ankles 2.5 bandage dresses gather where there (3) details matter! including pockets/buttons/huns/etc seriously help the believability of clothing.

Textile processes



Tie dye: a resist method of dyeing fabric. Create a pattern using string or elastic bands and a unique pattern will be revealed



Stencilling: cutting card patterns and sponging fabric paint into the gaps to create lettering or images on the fabric.

Distressing/cutting:


Using scissors to cut and knot fabrics, adding weaving or tassels.




Block print printing onto fabric using fabric paint on a wooden or foam block.
